## CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS - Enbridge playRites Awards Deadline: February 1, 2014

Each year, **Enbridge playRites Awards** are presented to **one Emerging and one Established Canadian Playwright** to aid in the development of a new English-language play. Committed to nurturing Canadian playwriting talent in partnership with **Alberta Theatre Projects**, this **\$3,000 Award** is generously underwritten by **Enbridge Inc.** Recipients will be announced during the **28th Annual Enbridge playRites Festival of New Canadian Plays March 6 – April 7, 2014 at Alberta Theatre Projects in Calgary.**

### **Established Canadian Playwrights:**

The Enbridge playRites Award for an **Established Canadian Playwright** can be used to undertake a play development project by contributing to the following related expenses:

- Completing a draft of your play
- Engaging dramaturgical expertise (travel costs, per diems, artist fees, etc.)
- Undertaking a workshop or convening a public reading (facility rental, professional fees, etc.)

### **Emerging Canadian Playwrights:**

The Enbridge playRites Award for an **Emerging Canadian Playwright** can be used to undertake a play development project by contributing to the following related expenses:

- Engaging dramaturgical expertise (travel costs, per diems, artist fees, etc.)
- Convening a public reading (facility rental, professional services of actors, etc.)
- Undertaking a workshop (per diems, professional fees, facility rental, etc.)

### **Please note the following conditions:**

- Projects to fund a production of a new play are ineligible
- Companies are ineligible
- Projects to fund tuition for the Applicant are ineligible
- Applicants must be citizens or landed immigrants of Canada
- Applicants to the Enbridge playRites Award for an **Established Canadian Playwright** must have had at least one of their plays produced by a member of the Professional Association of Canadian Theatres (PACT). ### **To apply, please include:**

- a short synopsis of your play (not a complete draft)
- a brief description of your play development process: your goals and schedule
- a simple budget that outlines how the Award funds will be used
- your current curriculum vitae

### **Assessment, Adjudication and Notification**

Applications are assessed by a Jury that includes the artistic staff of Alberta Theatre Projects, a member of the community investment department of Enbridge Inc. and a member of the community. The Recipients will be announced at a reception during 28th Annual Enbridge playRites Festival of New Canadian Plays.

### **Terms and Conditions**

The Recipient will receive 75% of the funds at the announcement of the Award. The remaining 25% will be provided to the Recipient upon conclusion of the project and receipt of a Final Report. The Final Report to include a detailed budget and a one-page document detailing how the play development project achieved the stated goals of the original application. **The Recipient must complete the Project within TWO (2) years from February 1, 2014.** A Recipient who fails to meet the reporting requirements may forfeit the balance of the Award, or be required to repay the funds already advanced, until the reporting requirements have been met.
